- 1) FOR YOUR PRIVATE INFORMATION WE ARE CONSIDERING USING THIS MAN FOR A HIGH PRIORITY ASSASSINATION TASK WHICH WOULD REQUIRE HIS LYING LOW IN GERMANY FOR CONSIDERABLE PERIOD COLLECTING NECESSARY INTELLIGENCE TO ENABLE HIM TO DO JOB.
- 2) BEFORE MAKING OFFICIAL APPLICATION FOR HIM WOULD GREATLY APPRECIATE YOUR ADVICE AS TO HIS SUITABILITY.
- 3) CAN YOU POSSIBLY GIVE US THIS WITHOUT DIVULGING TO HIM REAL NATURE OF TASK WE HAVE IN MIND.
