B.W. PERSONNEL.

(It.-Col. BIAISDEIL is one of the most important Allied BW Experts and could give more reliable information. Some French professors of medicine and biologists also have better data on BW than me. Frof. Sydney SMITH also knows more about this subject than anyone at FIAI.)

- Generalarzt Frof. Dr. BRANDT (Listed also under CW personnel).

 Probably Dr. SCHUMANN (Also listed under CW personnel). According to von KIENCK he was head of Wehrwissen schaftsamt (Science Dept. of Armed Forces) and chairman of the Biological (Bacterial) Warfare Committee, in addittion to his other activities See CW list). Together with Dr. BAYR he was in charge of the agricultural section of BW work.
- SS-General SCHWAB (See CW, para ...). Probably also responsible for BW in SS.
- SS-General KAMMLER (See CW) SS-Chief of new weapons, probably includin CW and BW. His knowledge is probably only second hand but he knows what fields have been covered and where documents, stocks and rilot plants are hidden. Some of these were secreted in the Russian 7one. It would be dangerous for us if he revealed this to the Russians. He could also tell them which scientists in these fields are in the Russian 7one.
- Prof. Fritz HILDEBRANDT. Chief of Pharmacological Institute,
 GIESSEN University. Denies knowledge of BW, but
 likely to have carried out experiments at
 GIESSEN, possibly with Dr. OSTERWALD.
- Dr. OSTERWAID! Young doctor who was brought back from the Russian front by Prof. WIRTH and Prof. HILDEBRANDT in '44, through OSENBERG. Denies all knowledge of BW but probably carried out experiments at GIESSEN

Dr. BAYER he was in charge of the agricultural section of BW work.

SS-General SCHWAB (See CW, para ...). Probably also responsible for BW in SS.

SS-General KAMMLER (See CW) SS-Chief of new weapons, probably includin CW and BW.
