TOP SECRET

Dr. SIMON, German Manager of W I (Centre Section)
at SÖMMERDA. Confirmed Communist, had spent
many years in a concentration camp. Had tried to
persuade other Germans to go to Russia. Unpopular
with other Germans at SÖMMERDA. May not have
taken an engineering degree but one in economics.
Description: Age approx 40; height 1.80 centimetres,
Blond hair, oval face.

(Dr. MARCHANT mentioned a Dr. Helmut SIMON on 17 Feb. EPS are coming to
see me to-day about Dr. SIMON who is now at FRANKFURT and pretends to be from
RAABE INSTITUTE at BLEICHERODE. If STENGER was correct, on 15 Feb 47,
this SIMON is a dangerous plant.)
