Outgoing Cable No. 5513 Separate Telegram 6: The Middle East

(President) Thank you, Prime Minister, for declaring a monetary amount in support for the Middle East. The United States is working to put together an assistance policy. Japan's decision will facilitate contributions from the other countries at the Middle East aid conference that we plan to hold in Washington in a few days.

(Prime Minister) It was good timing and really good that we could make our declaration.

Passed to all [Japanese] diplomatic missions in the United States (except for Agana and Detroit), Britain, Germany, France, Italy, Canada, GCC, Istanbul, Egypt, Syria, and Jordan (End)
