I hear that the Prime Minister will visit China in March. The United States would like to improve US-China relations, but for that it is necessary to overcome barriers [TN: rest of section blacked out]

(Foreign Minister) I have something to tell you. When I visited China recently, the Chinese side stressed that they appreciated the US-China Summit meeting in Seattle and that China, too, would like to improve US-China relations and, regarding cooperation in the Asia-Pacific region as well, would like to cooperate with the countries in it.
