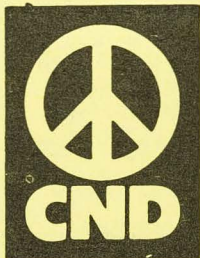

ASK THE CANDIDATES DO THEY SUPPORT

- 1 STOP CRUISE AND TRIDENT — opinion polls show that most people do not want American cruise missiles in Britain. Or to waste £10,000 million on trident submarine.

- 2 DEVELOPMENT NOT DESTRUCTION — the people of Southwark contribute £1.5 million every year to buy nuclear arms. Instead the money could be spent on better education, housing, and hospitals.

- 3 ACTION NOT WORDS — thirty-five years of "multi-lateral" talks and negotiations have not removed one single nuclear weapon. Talking about nuclear disarmament is not enough. Ask the candidate if they will be a member of parliament who supports ridding Britain of nuclear weapons.
