We are here to show that . . .

- . . . We reject our Government's policy of genocide
- . . . We refuse to be implicated in the Nuclear Arms Race
- . . . We condemn the vastly expensive development of Trident warheads at Burghfield and Aldermaston
- . . . We oppose absolutely the siting of warfighting Cruise missiles at Greenham.

*A crime is being committed here against humanity by our Government.
We do not consent to being involved in this madness.*

- We hope to begin making our Human Chain between the three sites about 1.00 pm.
- The mass release of balloons will be at around 2.00 pm, when flares and horns signal that the chain is complete along the 14 miles.
- After the Chain, we shall sing, dance, shout as we go to the festival site near Aldermaston.
- A limited bus shuttle service will help those unable to walk all the way.
- At the site, there will be a children's area, stages for us to entertain ourselves, a few short speeches and necessary facilities.
- Coaches will pick up alongside the festival site as arranged.

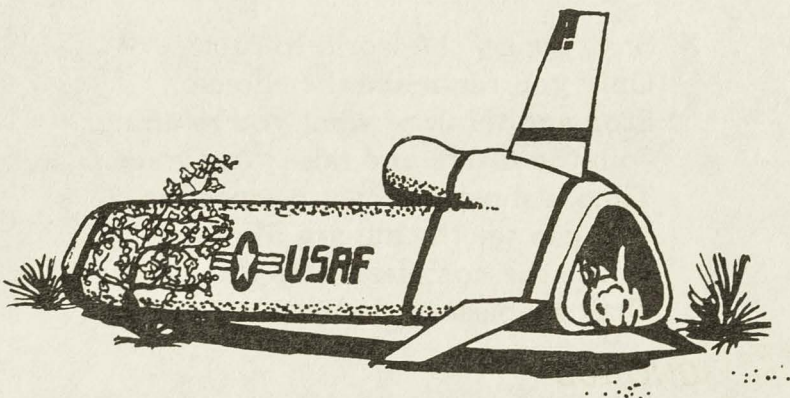
