The Minister of Defense has ordered:

1. Prepare [the following] by 30 September to be sent abroad:

- 10 passenger buses, including: 9 from those stored in war reserves in the Belorussian Military District and 1 from the Ministry of Defense motor pool;
- 21 Volga automobiles, including: 10 automobiles from the reserve of the Ground Forces and 11 automobiles from the reserve of the General Staff;
- 31 enlisted drivers, one for each vehicle.

2. Be guided by the requirements of the USSR Minister of Defense Directive N° 79602 of 13 June of this year for all questions connected with the assignment of drivers and vehicles.
