[Different handwriting] On 18 October in connection with the readiness for the flight of a TU 114 aircraft via Dakar, Marshal Zakharov ordered Cde. Seleznev not be sent since he would hold

a CC conference on the task, it more advisable to send combined-arms General A. Gribkov, which was done. In a day the documents were prepared and he flew out with a group at 2330 on the 18^{th} . As a consequence of engine damage, having reached [one word illegible], he returned at 0705 on the 19^{th} .
