1. DCM PASSED NON-PAPER AND CONVEYED REFTEL TALKING POINTS TO MOFA DEPUTY FOREIGN MINISTER MASUD TAKASHIMA, NOVEMBER 7. TAKASHIMA, WHO HAD JUST RECENTLY RETURNED FROM ANNUAL BILATERALS WITH MEMBERS OF PAKISTANI FOREIGN MINISTRY, SAID IT WAS FIRST TIME HE HAD HEARD THAT NUCLEAR EXPLOSIVE DESIGN AND DEVELOPMENT WORK WAS POSSIBLY UNDERWAY IN PAKISTAN. HE SAID AT RECENT BILATERALS IN ISLAMABAD, ONLY NUCLEAR PROBLEM TOUCHED UPON BY PAKISTANI FOREIGN MINISTER WAS THAT OF REPROCESSING PLANT FROM FRANCE; PAKISTANIS ALSO EXPRESSED ANNOYANCE AT USG "INTERFERENCE."

2. TAKASHIMA SAID THAT GOJ SHARED U.S. VIEWS ON DANGERS OF PAKISTANI MOVES, ALTHOUGH HE CONVEYED HIS IMPRESSION THAT PAKISTAN FELT PARTICULARLY THREATENED BY RECENT EVENTS IN AFGHANISTAN AND INSTABILITY IN SUB-CONTINENT. TAKASHIMA ADDED THAT PAKISTANIS VICE-FOREIGN MINISTER HAD REMARKED RUEFULLY THAT CENTO WAS JUST A "PIECE OF PAPER."
