Ambassador Ni [Zhiliang]:

The October 4 telegram was received.

□Please pay regular attention to the situation of the American puppet army's advance north and the People's Army's retreat to the north and activities in the enemy's rear area.

□Hope that you will be able to observe closely and collect information on the combat operation situation and experience of the 12th Division's attack on and occupation of Wonju.

□Pak Il U has returned to North Korea. [We] have spoken to him face-to-face about everything and he will pass it all on to Premier Kim [Il Sung].
