DURING JANUARY 14 MEETING WITH DEPUTY PRIME HINISTER NAM ON ECONOMIC ISSUES, HE VERY QUICKLY TURNED CONVERSATION WITH ME TO ROK REPROCESSING PLANT. NAM WELCOMED VISIT OF WASHINGTON GROUP JANUARY 22 ABOUT WHICH HE HAD BEEN INFORMED BY PRESIDENTIAL SECRETARY GENERAL KIH. CHUNG-YOM. NAM SAID ROKE HAD COME "LONG HAY" TOWARD REVERSING ITS POSITION ON PUNCHASE OF FRENCH REPROCESSING FACILITY. HOMEVER, HE FELT THAT MORE THAN ONE ROUND OF DISCUSSIONS WOULD BE REQUIRED TO ACHIEVE FINAL DECISION ON CANGELLATION HE URGED THAT WE NOT PUSH THE PROCESS TOO FAST, I RESPONDED THAT IN USG VIEW, DISCUSSIONS WITH HIGH LEVEL WASHINGTON GROUP, INCLUDING VERY KNOWLE-GEABLE OFFICIALS, SHOULD PROVINE SUFFICIENT BASIS FOR IMMEDIATE CANCELLATION AND THAT HE ARE NOT PREPARED FOR FOLLOW-UP DISCUSSIONS UNTIL DECISION NADE TO CANCEL. MAN EXPRESSED HAPE THIS WOULD BE THE CASE BUT REITER TED HIS CONCERNS AND URGED AGAIN HE GIVE IT A BIT MORE TIME SINCE RORG HAS COME A LONG DISTANCE ALREADY. HE ADOFD THAT MINISTER CHOI NOW RECOGNIZES PROHIBITIVE ECONOMIC COST OF NATIONAL REPROCESSING, BUT ROKE STILL NEEDS ASSURENCES ON US POSITIVE ACTIONS'
