ANYTHING READ AS ENCOURGEMENT TO YOUTH COULD CREATE SITUATION PUTTING ADDITIONAL HEAVY PRESSURES ON REMAINING PARTY LEADERS HHILE DISCOURAGEMENT COULD BE INTERPRETED AS LACK OF SUPPORT. MEDIA SHOULD MAINTAIN POLICY OF RAPID REPORTING OF NEWS AND PRESS COMMENTS WITH FULL ATTRIBUTION TO SOURCES ESPECIALLY IN CASES WHERE REPORTS VAGUE AS TO PRECISE FACTS. BEAM
