

Further to the deliberations at the seventh Council meeting and in view of the recent changes to the conventional armaments export control system, the Department of Foreign Affairs herewith confirms that it has no objection to the issuance of the following import/export permits for material and technology which are controlled by the Non-Proliferation of Weapons of Mass Destruction Act:

9507/04 (USA), 9507/05 (UAE), 9507/07 (France and Canada), 9507/08 (France), 9507/09 (Ireland), 9507/10 (USA, UK and France), 950803 (France), 9508/07 (Botswana) and 9508/09 India).
