SOUTH AFRICAN NUCLEAR INTENTIONS: KALAHARI FACILITY

1. Following Mr Wall's letter of 8 September to Mr Cartledge, the Prime Minister has said that we should try to establish the purpose of the Kalahari facility.
2. During the recent Nuclear Suppliers Group meeting, I took the opportunity to discuss the matter with Mr Nye, Deputy to the Under Secretary for Security Assistance in the State Department.
3. I submit a draft letter to No 10 Downing Street. It incorporates amendments by Sir A Duff to an earlier version which I submitted last week.
4. EESD, GSAD, PUSD and the Ministry of Defence concur.
