VISIT TO RSA OF GENERAL YONA EFFRAT, ISRAELI DEFENCE FORCE RESERVE

1. The former Chief of the SA Defence Force, Genl M.A. de M. Malan, has expressed his desire to invite General Yona Efrat, an erstwhile student colleague in 1962 during the Regular Command and General Staff Officers Course at Fort Leavenworth Kansas, USA, to visit the RSA for a period of 10 days at his convenience.
2. The purpose of his visit is for General Yona Efrat, who is the managing director of the Israeli Petroleum Services, to gain insight into our industrial potentials and fuel processing plants such as SASOL and Secunda.
3. General Yona Efrat will be accompanied by his wife and personal staff officer.
4. Funds for the proposed visit are available at CSOPS budget under item 7-01-43-501 and the estimated costs are as follows :
  - a. Accommodation (3 persons)
    - i. Seven days in Service accommodation at R20 per day R420
    - ii. Two days in the Kruger National Park at R60 per person per day (5 persons) R600
    - iii. One day hotel accommodation for 3 persons at R50 per person per day R150
    - iv. Additional meals at R20 each R100
  - b. Transport
    - i. SAAF 9 hours by Mercurius at R665 per hour R5 985  
2 hours by Puma at R482 p h R964
    - ii. Road Transport (estimated) R300
  - c. Receptions
    - i. One cocktail/buffet R400
    - ii. Three formal dinners R900


