## **Summary:**

The interim report from the US Embassy in Buenos Aires, filed just past the 1 September deadline, confirms the sale of 100 tons of yellow cake uranium to Israel over the course of a three-year period, beginning 1 January 1963. The uranium was to be used solely for the peaceful use of nuclear energy.

According to the provisions of Decree No. 1098 of February 8, 19 (Embassy A-58, July 21, 1964), the sale of a total of 100 tons of "y cake" at a minimum FOB price of US\$15 per kilogram of U <sub>3</sub> 0 <sub>8</sub> is author Sales contracts are permitted over a period of three years starting January 1, 1963, and the shipment of the material contracted may be extended nine months beyond that period. The decree specifies that proceeds of sales must exclusively be employed in the acquisition of machinery and equipment for the production and treatment of atomic ematerials and an itemized list of the equipment to be received in exfor the U <sub>3</sub> C <sub>8</sub> exported forms part of the decree. production capacity of U<sub>3</sub>O<sub>8</sub> will be about 120 tons, when the plant in Mendoza is completed and in operation within the coming year. Ing. Bancora of the Commission explained that the Commission is currently producing at the rate of about 60 tons per year at the Cordoba plant. The production figure covering 1963, which was given the former AEC representative, was only 10,254 kilograms. However, it is known that production capacities are being increased. From the mentioned statement of Admiral Quihillalt, adequate supplies of the material should be available for fulfillment of any contracts up to 100 tons to be shipped within the 3-year period mentioned in the decree.
