Dear Mr. Stavropoulos,

I have been directed by the United Nations Commission for the Unification and Rehabilitation of Korea to seek your views whether, in transmitting the Commission's forthcoming report to the Secretary-General, it could request the latter to submit the report to the General Assembly for its consideration only in the event that the Korean question is to be included as an item, or a supplementary item, in the General Assembly provisional agenda.

The obvious reason behind the Commission's thinking is its wish not to appear to be initiating a debate on the Korean question, but it will leave the question of submitting its report to the General Assembly at the discretion of the Secretary-General should the Korean question be proposed for discussion.

Your early comments on this subject will be greatly appreciated.
