Dear Mr. Narasimhan,

The Chairman of the Committee of UNCURK has invited, on behalf of the Committee, the secretaries-general of both the Democratic Republican Party and the New Democratic Party to appear separately before its members and express their views on the election campaigns. In so doing, the Committee has followed its past practice to ascertain the views of various political leaders as part of UNCURK's mandate to observe the general elections in the Republic of Korea.

Mr. J.M.J.B. Horak, who has recently been appointed as adviser to the Netherlands Delegation, attended the meeting of the Committee of UNCURK yesterday in his capacity as an acting alternate during the absence of Mr. I. Verkade, who is going on home leave.

The Economic Affairs Officer, Mr. Pierre Hudicourt, arrived in Seoul on 22 February and has assumed his new duty. I was particularly impressed by his background, especially his previous career as a former delegate of the Haitian Foreign Service, and I am sure that he will be of great help to us in carrying out the work of the Commission.
