Your Excellency,

We the members of Nepal Korea Friendship Association and Nepal Committee For Supporting Reunification of Korea extend our compliments to Your Excellency and take this liberty to address Your Excellency expressing our deep concern on the fact that Korea still remains divided thirty-four years after its liberation. We beg to draw Your Excellency's attention to the fact that the U.N. resolution adopted by the 30th session of U.N. General Assembly regarding withdrawal of all the foreign troops occupying south Korea under the U.N. signboard and on promotion of North-South Korean dialogue for independent and peaceful reunification of Korea has not been implemented as yet. The continued presence of U.S. forces in south Korea and its intervention in the internal affairs of Korea is the main obstacle to the way of independent peaceful reunification of Korea.

We fully support the reasonable and fair proposals of the Government of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea as reiterated in the recent speech delivered by His Excellency Kim Il Sung, President of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea on the occasion of the 30th anniversary of the Founding of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea. We beg to convey to Your Excellency our firm opinion that the Korean people should be allowed to unify their fatherland peacefully with their own efforts without

any outside interference or counselling including that of the United Nations. Four years have passed since the adoption of the resolution on Korean question in 1975. We strongly demand that the U.S. Government should immediately withdraw all its troops and military equipment from south Korea in accordance with the resolution on Korean reunification adopted by the 30th session of the U.N. General Assembly.

We sincerely hope that Your Excellency will give due attention and consideration to the implementation of U.N. resolution on Korea adopted at its 30th General Assembly.
