Subject: An indictment against Soviet Russia as an aggresser na tion on Chinese southering

Inasmuch as the reason d'etre of the United Nations is to maitain international peace it is imperative that aggressor nations, specially member nations must be properly displined when committing wrongful acts—the causes of war. So being sware of my individual capacity I however, feel it necessary to put up a formal indictment against Soviet Russia and request the United Nations to make out proper measurements to the offender that the peaceful order of the world may not be endangered

First of all I protest against albeing Soviet Russia to remain a member in the United Mations. It is no secrets that since the advent of the United Mations, the entire world had been fallen into the crutches of the communistic bloc, increasing insteadof lessening international tension. It is most regretable that Russia armed with secrete treaties like that of the Yalta Agreements openly defied the enlightened opinions of the world, in exploiting Fanchuria, in instigating the Moa-tse-tung and Kuo- mo- yo regime as well as in promting the Kores War. That the United Mation can overlook such aggressive actions and still retain its name as organ for international peace efforts is a historic farce and calumity.. I am constrained therefore voice the indignation of 450 000 000 suffering souls and ask for immediate remedy Specically we demand the return of the Sarharland Islands and other territories robbed by Russia in the past two hundred years; and that proper penalties be applied to the latter. Secondly, as a result of the Yelta Agreements, engineered by Roosvelt, Churchill and Stalin millions of Chinese people have become victims of the aggressive acts that they are starving to death in Hongkong and Facau. Before any final asttlement is to be reached the signatory-Powers must be held responsible for present livelihood. The United Nations is the one organ. to assume the directions roles.

Thirdly, Pres. Chiang Kai Sek of China has rendered invaluable serves to his Allies in Burma and Hongkong during the War. he is truly the white hope of Freedom and Democracy. The Juited ations should never consider sitting the Peking Reds, his and democracy's enemy. Fourthly, That Seviet Russia is abetting disturbances everywhere is matter of common knownled She should be declared offender and be held responsible for all damages of life and property Fiftly. Soviet Russia must be made to declare the parts she is playing in the government of an and Ruo. The United Nations should do all to prevent further complicity. The above represents the true feelings of 450 000 000 Chinese people. We are looking for posititive action. Tay Providence forbid that the United Nations be degenerated into a more accomplice of aggressors; for the entire human race deputed on its present determination.
