On behalf of the people of Korea, I have the honor to express our deep appreciation for your letter of February 11, 1955, in which you expressed support for our cause in fighting Communist penetration of the Ryukyu and other free nations of Asia.

We, the free peoples of Asia, are always grateful to the people and Government of the United States for the continued endeavors to protect democracy and our free form of government. American diplomatic officers in South-East Asia helped make it possible to form the Asian Peoples' Anti-Communist League at the Chinhai Conference in June 1954. We will appreciate it if you can give every possible assistance to the people in the Ryukyu Islands and to their representatives. They can greatly strengthen our common stand by attending the next conference of the League, which is scheduled to be held in early May this year.

I am sending a letter to Mr. Tsai Chang, at 11 - 9 Nawa City, Ryukyu, the Chief Delegate of the people of the Ryukyu Islands to our League, informing him of your generous offer to help our cause in fighting Communism and protecting democratic ideals.

Again, I appreciate your warm support for the activities of the League, and wish that the best of health be with you always.
