THE MASSIVE INSURRECTION IN KANGJU IS STILL OUT OF CONTROL AND POSES AN ALARMING SITUATION FOR THE ROK MILI-TARY WHO HAVE NOT FACED A SIMILAR INTERNAL THREAT FOR AT LEAST THO DECADES. THE IMMEDIATE CAUSE IS OBVIOUSLY THE EXTENT TO WHICH THE POLITICAL CRACKDOWN HIT KIM DAE JUNG (M=R: KIM TAE=CHUNG) AND OTHER NATIVES OF CHOLLA, BUT BY NOW ALMOST ALL ELEXENTS OF THE POPULATION SEEM TO BE ENGAGED IN A VIOLENT, PROVINCIAL FREE FOR ALL REFLECTING DEEP-STATED HISTORICAL, PROVINCIAL ANTAGONISMS. AT LEAST 150,400 PEOPLE ARE INVOLVED, THERE HAS BEEN GREAT CESTRUC-TION, AND OUR MOST RECENT INFORMATION IS THAT THE RIOTERS HAVE STOKEN INTO ASMORIES AND SEIZED MEAPONS, LIVE AMMUNITION, AND DEMOLITIONS. THE KOREAN ARMY PLANS TO PULL ITS MILITARY PORCES OUT OF THE CITY TONIGHT, MAINTAIN-ING ROADBLOCKS AND CONCENTRATING DEFENSE ON TWO MILITARY INSTALLATIONS AND A PRISON CONTAINING 2,920 LEFTISTS. AUTHORITIES ARE TRYING TO GET A CEASEPIRE SO THAT THEY CAN TALK TO THE RIOTERS ABOUT THEIR DEMANDS FOR AN APOLOGY, RELEASE OF PRISONERS, AND REMOVAL OF MARTIAL LAW FORCES. WHILE ALL THESE MOVES SEEM INTELLIGENT, THEY HAVE NOT WORKED SO FAR AND THE DECEMBER 12 GENERALS DRVIOUSLY FEEL THREATENED BY THE WHOLE AFFAIR.

MESSAGE (CONTINUED)

SE GENERAL MICKMAN HAS AGREED TO A HIGH INTERNAL ALERT STATUS AGAINST INFILTRATION, AND HE HAS INFORMALLY TAKEN SOME MEASURES ASSOCIATED WITH DEFIGON 3. HE HAS ALSO URGED THAT DEFENSE CONSIDER WHAT FORCE AUGMENTATIONS MIGHT BE POSSIBLE IF HE SECHE INCREASINGLY CONCERNED ABOUT THE POTENTIAL FOR NORTH KOREAN EXPLOITATION. HE HAS BEEN CAREFUL TO AVOID ANY FORMAL ACTIONS WHICH MIGHT BE PROVUCATIVE AND LEAD TO AN ESCALATION WITH NORTH KOREA.

4. WE HAVE DISCUSSED, IN ADDITION, WHAT WE MIGHT DO. ONE MAN WHO COULD HELP IF HE WERE WILLING WOULD BE KIM DAE JUNG, BUT HE IS IN JATE AND PROBABLY WOULD NOT BE WILLING TO BE HELPFUL UNLESS HE COULD EXTRACT FAREREACHING CONCESSIONS. NO OTHER HERCES ARE LIKELY TO STEP FORWARD. IF THE RIOT-ING GETS EVEN MORE SERIOUS, I SUGGEST THE DEPARTMENT CONSIDER REITERATION OF THE MAY 18 STATEMENT FOCUSING IT ON A CALL FOR ALL CONCERNED TO CALM THE SITUATION, ESTAB-LISH A DIALOGUE WITH EACH OTHER, AND AVOID A FISSURE WHICH COULD GREATLY INCREASE EXTERNAL THREATS. THE STATEMENT COULD CONCLUDE BY TAKING NOTE OF PYONGYANGIS PROTESTATIONS OF INNOCENCE AND STATE THAT HE INTEND TO HOLD THEM TO THEIR DECLARATION. AS OF MON, I AM AGAINST ANY LOCAL AMERICAN STATEMENT BECAUSE IT COULD BACKFIRE WITH CHARGES THAT WE HERE IN COLLUSION WITH THE GOVERNMENT. A STATE-MENT IN MASHINGTON WHICH BALANCED THE CALL FOR MODERATION TO SOTH SIDES MOULD POSE LESS DIFFICULTY. UNFORTUNATELY. NO AMERICAN STATEMENT IN A SITUATION OF CENSORSHIP AND RIOTING IS SOING TO BE HEARD BY MANY PROPLE. GLEYSTEEN
