At the present time we are down in Chinhae, enjoying the fresh air of the sea and the quietude of the scene. The plum blossom is already opening and it is a beautiful sight.

We always recall the arrival of General Van Fleet in Korea, when we met him in Chinhae for the first time and we remember with pleasure his later visits here.

A short time ago we received a periodical for the General, which I hesitate to forward because it is in such bad shape, but you will find on Page 2 a reference to him.
