Dear Dr. Rhee:

You will recall that we discussed the subject of a Corporation Law for Korea.

In the United States, we have a separate Corporation Law for each state. It coursed to me that Korea could have a National Law covering the entire subject for all of the Provinces. This subject will entail a lot of research work and it may be thirty days before I will have it in shape to submit a copy to you.

In the meantime, I wanted you to know that I have not forgotten it and that I am working on same.

I will see Representative Brownson again on Tuesday the 25th.

I just learned today, that the pouch leaves Washington on Monday instead of Thursday. I wrote you additional letters covering different subjects. They will probably all reach you at one time.
