Dear Mr. Yoo:

I must confess I am deeply disappointed in your feelings toward me and this company, all because I do not go along with your idea on the records pertaining to Miss Kim and Mr. Vandt.

You expected me to put up \$5,000 in which, as I see it, Mr. Vandt to all outward appearances, would be the only one to financially gain by virtue of me putting up the money. If Mr. Vandt would have stated that he would not have received any finances in the way of royalties, I then would have been interested from a philanthropic point of view.

I certainly am not pleased with your attitude pertaining to the above program. I am leaving for Korea, Wednesday morning and intend to pursue this matter further. I believe an apology is due to myself and Korean-American Purchasing & Sales, Inc.
