Dear Nrs. libeet

Because of your interest in the Imundang building, 30 Kmm Hun Tong, the Eighth Army has for a long time been sttempting to release it from military occupancy. I am happy to report that we now intend to return this building to the Assistant Chief of Staff, 0-5 ROK Army on or about 1 August 1954. The occupying unit has worked hard to improve the condition of the property so that it will be returned to ROKA control in at least as good a state of repair as when it was initially occupied by the military.

Knowing the stringency of the housing situation in Secul, this headquarters is making a continuing effort to contrast our real estate holdings, consistent with absolute military requirements.
