Receipt of your letter of 10 July 1954, addressed to Major Alvin D Ungerleider, requesting clearance into Korea for the family of Dr. William A. Glenn is acknowledged.

Entry permits for the clearance into Korea of United Nations civilian personnel are issued by the Commanding General United States Army Forces, Far East. That headquarters has been notified that the Eighth United States Army interposes no objections to the entry of Dr. Glenn's family into Korea on the basis that their logistic support will not be requested nor provided from military sources.
