
Dear Dr. Rhee:

You evidently did not receive my letter in which I accepted your invitation to come to Korea. I am now arranging my affairs here in Washington so that I can leave here not later than the first part of January.

I expect to fly to the West Coast and take the President Cleveland boat to Yokohama. The reason for the boat is that it will give me an opportunity for a short vacation and a badly needed rest. I haven't taken a vacation now for two years.

You may send the funds for transportation direct to me. I will work out the schedule for a trip to and return from Korea.
