#### 10 June 1954

THE REPUBLIC OF KORSA SALUTES THE BIGHTH UNITED STATES ARMY ON THIS TENTH ANNIVERSARY OF ITS BIRTH. ACTIVATED AT MEMPHIS, TENNESSEE, ON JUNE TENTH, 1944 ESPECIALLY FOR SERVICE IN THE PACIFIC THEATHER, THE EIGHTH ARMY MADE MORE THAN SIXTY AMPHIBIOUS LANDINGS IN MOVING FROM NEW CUNEA TO THE PHILIPPINES AND IN PREPARING FOR THE ASJAULT ON JAPAN. IT LANDED IN JAPAN AUGUST 30. 1945 AND GAME TO KOREA BARLY IN JULY 1950 TO TAKE A LEADING PART IN THE WAR AGAINST COMMUNIST AGURESSION. UNDER GENERALS EIGHELBERGER, THE LATE WALTON H. WALKER, GENERALS RIDGEWAY, VAN FLEST AND TAYLOR AND NOW UNDER ITS DEPUTY COMMANDER GENERAL GLARKE, THE EIGHTH ARMY HAS UPHELD THE FINEST TRADITIONS OF MILITARY SERVICE. DURING THE KOREAN FIGHTING TWENTY UNITS FROM UNITED NATIONS COUNTRIES WERE ASSOCIATED WITH IT. KOREA ALWAYS WILL BE GRATEFUL TO THE EIGHTH ARMY, WHICH HAS SHED BLOOD ON KOREAN SOLL TO CREATE A PERMANENT TIE. WE ARE HAPPY TO EXTEND OUR CONGRATULATIONS ON THIS TENTH ANNIVERSARY. SYBGMAN RHEE.
