Dear Mr. Yu:

Reference is made to your letter of 23 March which requested assistance in arranging a clearance for Archbishop Paul Yupin.

Arrangements have been made for the Archbishop's clearance to enter Korea as you requested. In the event the Archbishop comes to Korea by way of Japan, the necessary visa will be awaiting him at Headquarters, Army Forces Far East, Pershing Heights, Tokyo. This clearance will provide for entry into Korea without logistical support from military sources.
