DEPARTURE DEADLINE FOR LOTH DIVISION SET:

HEADQUARTERS, EIGHTH ARMY --- The 40th Infantry Division will depart
Korea in late May, 1954, arriving in the United States during the month
of June, General Maxwell D. Taylor, Commanding General, Eighth Army,
announced today. The division, a California National Guard Unit, will
revert to State control upon its return.

Only those officers and enlisted men assigned to the LOth Division who are eligible for rotation under current criteria at the time of redeployment will accompany the division when it leaves Korea. These individuals will be formed into a unit which will act as escort for the records and colors of the division and participate in such parades and peremonies as may be desired after arrival in the United States. The endort will number about 1,000 men. Those men in the division not highly for rotation will be transferred to other units in Korea.
