MEMORANDUM (B) To Clarify

July 15, 1955

TO: President Syngman Rhee

I quote excerpt from your letter of June 28th:

QUOTE. "Let you know that the Ambassador found it difficult to help you in everything you wished him to do for you." UNQUOTE.

This peace a mystery for me as God is my judge, I have never asked the Ambassador to do directly or indirectly, anything for me personally. The only matters I have discussed with him at any time were matters helpful to Korea.

I am sorry to say that I have not had the slightest cooperation from the Embassy on anything which I have presented there.
