TOKYO (AFP) —— Japanese Prime Minister Hatogans said today that
he decided to meet with ROK President Syngman Rhee if possible in
an attempt for an early establishment of the normal diplomatic
relations between the two nations which had beendeadlooked for years.

In an awar to the Kyodo News Agency during his election of again tour at Fukushima today, the Japanese Paime Minister said that he will soon instruct his Foreign Office to take necessary steps to arrange for the conference with President Syngman Rhee.
