From the President

I wish to acknowledge receipt of your letter of 30 July No. 90, and your copy report to the Acting Foreign Minister, also copy of a release which you proposed to make on 15 August.

Certain minor changes have been made in this statement which has been re-typed for your convenience and is forwarded herewith. I hope you receive it in time to release it in this form.

I am advised that the Minister of Agriculture will be unable to accept the invitation of the ICA because his work at the Ministry does not permit even one day's absence at the present time. He will write a letter to Manila asking that another man be sent from the Ministry. Mr. C. H. Kim of the Agricultural Bank will accept the invitation.
