To Minister Young Kee Kim

From the President

I thank you for your Report No. 87, contents of which have been noted. I have also received copy of your report dated 29 June to the Acting Foreign Minister.

An invitation has been extended to Vice President Nixon to visit Korea during his tour of the East. As yet we have had no acknowledgement and no announcement has been made as to whether he will or will not accept.

It is noted with interest in your report to the Acting Foreign Minister that recommendations by the Philippine Government to the Vice President involve the reassignment of Minister Thomas de Castro to be replaced by Minister Cosme P. Garcia. A
