A Trade and Goodwill Mission sponsored by the Chamber of Commerce of the Philippines will visit Japan, Korea, Bangkok and Saigon to look toward the purchase of capital goods and exportation of manufactured goods from the Philippines. The Mission will be headed by Efren V. Mendoza, Director of the Chamber and President of the Association of Philippine Traders with Japan; Iarry Henares Jr., Director of the Philippine Chamber of Industries; Enrique Angeles; Juan P. Juan; Teofilo Tanjuatco and others. The Trade and Goodwill Mission is invited by the Tokyo Chamber of Commerce. The party is scheduled to leave Manila on June 5th and very likely, they will stay one week or longer in Japan before proceeding to Seoul.
