June 9 - June 12, 1956

- 0800 H Arrival of visiting naval vessels at the Quarantine Anchorage. Philippine Navy Boarding Officer and representative from the Korean Legation will board the Flagship.
- 0845 H Visiting ships dock at pier #5. AFP representatives will meet ships and PN Band will be on hand to provide music.
- 0900 H Commodore Yong Woon Lee and his staff depart pier #5 for the Korean Legation.
- 0910 H Call on the Korean Minister Young Kee Kim.
- 0950 H Arrival at Gate #2, Camp Murphy.
- 0955 H Call on Chief of Staff, AFP.
- 1035 H Call on the Flag Officer in Command, PN.
- 1100 H Depart from the U.S. Embassy Landing for Sangley Point to call on Rear Admiral Wendell Switzer.
- 1400 H- Return call by the Korean Minister aboard the Flagship.
- 1430 H Return call by representative of the Chief of Staff, AFP.
- 1500 H Return call by the Flag Officer in Command, PN.

- 1700 H Visiting Naval Band Concert at the Luneta Park.

- 1830 H Korean Dinner in honor of Commodore Yong Woon Lee and the Commanding Officers of the visiting naval vessels to be given by Korean Minister and Mrs. Kim at the Korean Legation residence.
- 1800 H USO Buffet Supper for Officers, Midshipmen and Enlisted men to at the Manila Hotel 2200 H

- 1330 H Depart for Tagaytay.
