Dear Madame Rhee:

Since our return, I have been very busy in looking after the entertainment of the Korean delegates as well as the formal dinner we gave for the Chinese Ambassador and Mrs. Chen Chin-mai. We are all glad to be back home after a two-week visit to Korea where we got more or less defrosted. Now, the weather is getting very warm and the heat with high humidity is on the rise.
