I am pleased to inform your Excellency that we received a letter inviting us to the inauguration of Ezeiza Atomic Center on 20th December. At the occasion, we will also be invited for a scientific exchange between Argentine and Brazilian technicians to whom your Excellency gently extended the invitation.

It is with great honour that I accept the invitation that besides the opportunity to attend the inauguration of another Center of atomic research in Latin America, it will provide me with the opportunity of visiting this beautiful and brother country and of strengthening the traditional bonds of friendship and fraternity between the Argentines and Brazilians.
