1. In its humanitarism Law discussion which lasted for rearly three days, Jopon submitted a risolution arising in stop use of all ruclear alexanse and puclear test. But the Red Cross International Committee already samuted the drapt rules of pratisting the Cipilian population in time of War in cluding the resolutions of Taronto Conference of 1952 and the resolution of the Brand of Jupernous of the League of the Red Cross Conference of Oslo, 1954 which all included the articles concurring the use and the limits of the nuclear Weapons. The U.S. do not fopor the Laponer resolution but they rather Cooperate with the Red Cross Committees resolution. along with Philippines, from the Lurian deligation I took the floor and gape an argument that additional resolution such as the resolution put up by the Japonese deligation is not really receivery hisaure it draft rules submitted by the Red Cross Committee has already included 3

I. We supported our resolution regarding the repatriation of our war wishing persons that taken away py the south hours Communist force. Just before our resolution, Conada also samuted the similar resolution which aims is repatriate past of the family members of the kurspean immigrant families in Conada, who are still held in the Communist areas. So it was agreed by the Conference, that herein problems should be included in the Conadina resolution since the ruture of these two resolutions are almost some. Thus, our resolution was not expanditly Considered.

3. about the six Lourn P.O.W. numbers in Judia, We had opportunity to neet two of them who are planning in go to argentina. The mimorandum for this promise is attached to the ugular report which wiel he submitted to His breiching soon as the report has heen completed.
