I wish to acknowledge receipt of your three letters, Nos. 5, 6 and 7.

I am pleased to hear that the Sydney Fair articles arrived safely for exhibition at the Manila exposition scheduled for 30th November and that you are preparing to make this a fine success with a Korean style display house.

The Foreign Minister has advised that a brief of instructions for you as chief Korean delegate of the International Red Cross conference to be held in New Delhi, is being forwarded to you. Consul Choi Kyu Ha from Tokyo will be alternate delegate and Miss Shinsil Kim and another Red Cross member will make up the remainder of the delegation.

I am awaiting advice from the Foreign Minister as to what arrangements have been made with regard to your budget problems and hope to have an answer before this pouch departs.
