SUBJECT: Visit to Korea of Congressman Hayworth and His Party

In regard to Your Excellency's instructions dated August 30 concerning the arrival of US Congressman, Mr. Don Hayworth, and his party I am sending the following report as an interim report:

- a. Mr. Hayworth and two others, Mr. Curt Borchardt and Mr. Martin Cunningham, arrived in Tokyo on Tuesday, Oct. 4. The rest of the group consisting of Mr. Trebert H. McDonald and Mr. John V. Beamer, are due to arrive on Thursday, Oct. 6.
- b. The present itinerary for them made available by the US Embassy here indicates that they will leave for Seoul on Oct. 9. The definite schedule will not be known until the arrival of the entire group, however.
- c. This office will keep in touch with the group and will report to Your Excellency by cable as soon as definite information is received.

I am planning to give a luncheon party in honor of Mr. Hayworth and his party, if their schedule permits, before their departure for Secul.
