Tanaka Tatsuo, deputy chief cabinet secretary called me this morning to extend his dinner invitation for next Monday (12th). He stated he had Kishi's message to relay to me and also to discuss certain other problems, adding that if the Ambassador wished to come, he would be welcome. I accepted his invitation.

After an hour or so, Itagaki, director of the Asian Affairs Bureau of the Foreign Ministry contacted me to ask if I would agree to holding our next preliminary talk on Saturday (10th) at 10:00 a.m. at the Kayukaikan. I told him it would be fine.
