Additional notes dictated over the phone
by Madam Rhee from Chinhae

1. In case there is any occasion when you wish to show our special consideration, you may propose the time limit to 10 years if the Japanese voluntarily agree now to observe the Fishery Line.
2. The Japanese must assure us they will not arrest any detainees (after they have been released from the Omura or any other camp) or Korean nationals without specific legal charges.
3. We want them to deport several Korean fugitives from justice.
