建议以驱逐舰两艘予我。[X]亦无决定。蔡斯继谓派遣军队赴韩之事为有决定。当由外交途径向我商洽,彼并未受命转达等语,总统当告以。台湾本身安全问题须先解决,我始能考虑派遣军队赴韩问题。第七舰队只能协防台湾附近海面,至于台湾本岛必须在本岛陆上有喷射机[X]
