1. In connection with the report of Cde. Kuznetsov, People's Commissar of the Merchant Fleet, that on 17 October the Cruiser Kirov blew up on a mine in the region of Krasnaya Gorka, we suggest that the Politburo make following decision:

Appoint a Government Commission to investigate all the circumstances and reasons for the Cruiser Kirov accident on 17 October, composed of: Marshal Govorov (chairman), Chief of the Main Naval Staff Kucherov, Secretary of the Leningrad Oblast' Committee Kuznetsov, and Chief of the SMERSH Directorate of the NKVMF [People's Commissariat of the Navy] Gladkov.

- 2. The Commission is to immediately go to scene and submit the first report about its work to the USSR Council of People's Commissars by 25 October.
